Art Teacher Job Description

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, teaches one or more classes in the field of art to students in grades 6-12, assists in other school programs as assigned, and creates a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth with each students ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- x Teaches knowledge and skills in art, including but not limited to crafts, drawing, painting, lettering, design, commercial art, art history, and/or three-dimensional art to secondary students utilizing the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.
- x Instructs students in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.
- x Provides instruction by which students develop aesthetic concepts and appreciation and the ability to make qualitative judgments about art.
- x Demonstrates techniques in activities such as drawing, painting, and modeling, using standard and/or teacher prepared instructional materials.
- x Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide a balanced program of instruction, demonstration, and working time.
- x Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students with varying intellectual abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities.
- x Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior required to provide an orderly and productive studio environment.
- x Instructs students in proper care and use of tools and equipment and organizes storage areas and controls use of materials, equipment and tools to prevent loss or abuse.
- x Evaluates each students performance and growth in knowledge and understanding, and prepares progress reports.
