## Art Teacher Job Description

### DEFINITION

Under general supervision, teaches one or more classes in the field of art to students in grades 6-12, assists in other school programs as assigned, and creates a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth with each student's ability.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- x Teaches knowledge and skills in art, including but not limited to crafts, drawing, painting, lettering, design, commercial art, art history, and/or three-dimensional art to secondary students utilizing the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.
- x Instructs students in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.
- x Provides instruction by which students develop aesthetic concepts and appreciation and the ability to make qualitative judgments about art.
- x Demonstrates techniques in activities such as drawing, painting, and modeling, using standard and/or teacher prepared instructional materials.
- x Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide a balanced program of instruction, demonstration, and working time.
- x Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students with varying intellectual abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities.
- x Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior required to provide an orderly and productive studio environment.
- x Instructs students in proper care and use of tools and equipment and organizes storage areas and controls use of materials, equipment and tools to prevent loss or abuse.
- x Evaluates each student's performance and growth in knowledge and und

Work area requirements:

Regular or specialized classroom, on the playground, parking lot, bus stop areas and possibly field trips. Ability to use common school hand tools, computer, telephone and photocopy machine. Ability to transverse a 40 acre campus which could include asphalt, sidewalks, grass on playgrounds, dirt, and bus areas.

Physical requirements:

The time requirements are listed considering this wording and meaning:

- Lifting: Occasionally
- Reaching: Occasionally - Frequently
- Handing: Constantly
- Grasping: Constantly
- Fingering: Constantly
- Push/Pull: Occasionally

***\*Possession of a current California Driver's license, a DMV printout and the ability to be covered by the company auto insurance is required.***

Frequent motion:

- Twisting: Constantly
- Wrist flexion: Constantly
- Reaching to above shoulder level: Occasionally
- Reaching below shoulder level: Yes - Constantly
- Reaching to shoulder level: Occasionally
- Forward shoulder/neck flexion: Frequently
- Elbow flexion/extension: Constantly

Sensory requirements:

- Ability to see: Constantly
- Ability to hear: Constantly
- Ability to talk: Constantly
- Ability to smell: Constantly
- Ability to touch: Constantly

Must be able to deal with these environmental considerations:

- Odor: Occasionally
- Noise: Medium
- Humidity: Low
- Moisture: Occasionally
- Working inside: 95% of the day
- Working outside: 5% of the day
- Fluorescent lights: Constant
- Floor may be slippery at times: Medium
- Working in close quarters with others: Medium
- All day long; 36 desks in room - crowded/Constantly
- Heat - Do not have own controls; some teachers can control

This job requires:

- Alertness: Yes
- Attention to detail: Yes
- Ability to work in temperatures down to 40 degrees & up to 110 degrees: Yes
- The use of two hands: No
- Recall of names & dates: Yes

Ability to deal with psychological factors:

- Team work: High
- Frustration: High
- Able to work overtime as needed: Over 3 hours per day
- Dealing with angry teachers, students, parents: Occasionally
- Repetitive tasks: High
- Level of responsibility: High
- Must keep up with schedule: High

Physiological Factors :

- Must maintain a high level of consciousness: High, all day long
- Orientation to time, place, or person: Yes
- Ability to read at 12<sup>th</sup> grade level: Yes
