Job Description

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, teaches one or more classes in the field of computers to students in grades 6th through 8th, assists in other school programs as assigned, and creates a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each student's ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- x Teaches knowledge and skills in computers to secondary students utilizing the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.
- x Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students with varying intellectual abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities.
- x Instructs students in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures
- x Instructs students in proper care and use of materials and organizes storage areas and controls use of materials to prevent loss or abuse.
- x Evaluates each student's performance and growth in knowledge and understanding, and prepares progress reports.
- x Selects and requests instructional materials, books, etc., and maintains inventory records.
- x Maintains professional competence through in-service education activities provided by the district and/or in self-selected
