DEFINITION

Under direction of the school principal, organize and implement special education services for students with mild, moderate, and severe disabilities to enable them to be successful in the least restrictive environment, including general education classroom, learning centers, or special day classes. The role of Education Specialist is to ensure student's access the academic core curriculum and progress towards meeting instructional goals, provide instruction. The Education Specialist also serves as collaborator, co-teacher, and coach, with opportunities to provide professional development and instructional intervention that supports the site's Multi-tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) process through data teams and instructional
