Job Description

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, teaches one or more classes in the field of music to students in grades K through 5, assist in other school programs as assigned, and creates a flexible program and environment favourable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each students ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Teaches knowledge and skills in the field of music, which may include general, instrumental or choral music to elementary students utilizing the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.

Instructs students in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.

Provides instruction by which students develop aesthetic concepts and appreciations and the ability to make qualitative judgments about music.

Recruits students to receive instruction in playing standard band and orchestra instruments.

Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide a balanced program of instruction, demonstration, and working time.

Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of pupils with varying intellectual and artistic abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior required to provide an orderly and productive studio environment.
