MUSIC – SECONDARY (Instrumental/Choral) Job Description

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, teaches one or more classes in the field of music to students in grades 6 through 12, assists in other school programs as assigned, and creates a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each student's ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Teaches knowledge and skills in the field of music, which may include general, instrumental or choral music to secondary students utilizing the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.

Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students with varying intellectual abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities.

Provides instruction by which students develop aesthetic concepts and appreciations and the ability to make qualitative judgments about music.

Recruits students to receive instruction in playing standard band and orchestra instruments.

- x Instructs students in proper care and use of instruments and equipment and organizes storage areas and controls use of materials and instruments to prevent loss or abuse.

Evaluates each student's performance and growth in knowledge and understanding, and prepares progress reports.

Selects and requisitions instructional materials, books, etc., and maintains inventory records.

Maintains professional competence through in-service education activities provided by the District and/or in self-selected professional growth activities.

Participates cooperatively with the appropriate administrator to develop the method by which he/she will be evaluated in conformance with district guidelines.

Communicates with parents and school staff on student progress.
