

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical requirements indicated below are examples of the physical aspects that this position classification must perform in carrying out essential job functions

- f* will frequently exert 50 to 75 pounds of force to lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects
- f* will walk or stand most of the time, but may be required to bend, stoop, crouch, kneel, reach above shoulder level, and/or to ascend and descend a step stool, step ladder, scaffolding, and ramps
- f* must possess the ability to hear and perceive the nature of sound
- f* must possess visual acuity and depth perception
- f* must be capable of providing written and oral information, both in person and over the telephone
- f* must possess the manual dexterity to operate business-related equipment and to handle and work with various objects and materials

Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable a person with a disability to perform the essential functions of the job.
