## **GROUNDS MAINTENANCE WORKER II**

### **DEFINITION**

Under the general supervision of the Grounds Supervisor, skillfully operates a variety of heavy duty grounds maintenance equipment; performs complex grounds maintenance and gardening functions and activities; and performs other related work as assigned and/or required.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- š operates a variety of power grounds equipment, including large gang mowers, tractors, back hoe equipment, and sweepers
- š performs a variety of specialized functions using a variety of tractor attachments
- š may drive truck with a trailer attachment in transporting heavy duty grounds maintenance equipment from work site to work site
- s services grounds maintenance equipment and makes minor adjustments and repairs, and performs a variety of preventative maintenance functions
- š mows large fields and sweeps large areas of asphalt and concrete
- š digs trenches for new gas lines, water mains, and electrical lines, and back fills the trenches as the various lines are laid
- š fills, levels, smoothes, and prepares areas for sidewalks, approaches, slabs, and in preparing landscaped areas for the planting of lawns and a variety of plants, shrubs, and trees
- š may smooth and level athletic fields and running tracks
- š may spray for weeds and insect control
- š may move furniture and equipment and perform other grounds maintenance functions

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

**Knowledge of:** Operation, use, and maintenance of heavy duty grounds maintenance equipment; methods, procedures, materials, and tools commonly utilized in grounds maintenance and gardening work; safe working methods and procedures.

<u>Ability to</u>: Skillfully and safely operate and maintain large grounds equipment and use a variety of grounds maintenance and gardening tools; perform heavy manual work functions pertaining to grounds maintenance, equipment operation, and gardening work; understand and carry out oral and written directions; establish and maintain cooperative working relationships.

# **PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

The physical requirements indicated below are examples of the physical aspects that this position classification must perform in carrying out essential job functions.

- š will frequently exert 75 to 100 pounds of force to lift, carry, push, pull, or otherwise move objects
